How We Help with Tax Issues

The LITC may be able to help if you have a disagreement with the IRS. We provide free, confidential tax assistance to income-eligible taxpayers in Brown, Butler, Clermont, Clinton, Hamilton, Highland, and Warren Counties.

- We assist taxpayers who have received a Notice of Levy or Notice of Filing of Federal Tax Lien
- We represent taxpayers who are being audited by the IRS.
- We assist taxpayers who are affected by:
 - Identity Theft
 - Tax credit issues
 - Liens and levies
 - Past-due IRS debt
 - Innocent Spouse and Injured Spouse claims
 - Appeals
 - Tax court matters
- We do NOT prepare tax returns.

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Documents to Have Ready for Meetings

- Current income records such as pay stubs, receipts, or 1099s
- All letters, notices, bills and correspondence from the IRS
- A copy of all letters you wrote to the IRS
- Copy of tax returns in controversy
- Copies of all tax returns you filed in the past 5 years
- Any other documents that pertain to your tax issue

You should be prepared to answer questions regarding income, employment, and other relevant issues that may affect your tax issue. The more information you can provide, the better we can serve you.

In addition to providing support with tax problems, the LITC is able to:

- Speak to community groups
- Prepare materials about taxpayer rights
- Advise organizations and train staff who work with low income taxpayers
- Relieve stress of tax debt
- Build and retain assets
